AFSCME, LOCAL 1071.1 -UNION PRESIDENT, ART KRUPP:

AFSCME, Local 1071.1, Union President, Art Krupp addressed the board regarding riding together in the trucks without masks. He was told that we cannot oversee what the CDC recommends. He stated that all the other counties are riding together with no masks. Managing Director, Brent Friess stated that is not true. He has spoken to Clinton CRC, Genesee CRC and Gratiot and they are all enforcing this. Art went on to say that the union is upset about the \$2.00 per hour raise that they gave the part-time summer employees. Brent stated that we did do a survey and all the surrounding counties are paying more than our Road Commission is. The highest was \$19.00 per hour for engineering part time and the lowest was \$12.00 per hour. Chairman Michalec stated that he understands what they are saying, but we have not looked at these wages since 2015. Commissioner Constine stated that when Chris done the survey, we found we were way behind in wages on these positions. Art stated the timing was just did not go over well. Chairman Michalec stated that maybe it did as contract negotiations will be happening later this year. Managing Director, Brent Friess went over MIOSHA's guidelines and that we are required to follow these guidelines. This is costing us more money to operate. We are less than half of our employees that have been vaccinated.

Shiawassee County Commissioner, John Plowman reported on the following: A) Solar farm discussion and negotiating for property into Saginaw County for another solar farm. Lansing Board of Water and Light will be one of the big purchasers of these farms B) Electric car is just like filling your car up with gas. It will cost you about the same to charge it as it would to fill it with gas - Once this gets more predominant, where will the road tax come from? C) Re-arranging our administrative office to accommodate the Human resources position D) They really do not know the exact amount of the COVID funding they are going to receive of the 13 million, it is estimated around 7 million dollars, but that is not a set in stone figure E) Audit is going really well F) Shiawassee County property valuations increased by 120K dollars – tax surplus should increase as well due to this G) Treasurer, Julie Sorenson said only 24 properties in 2018 did not pay their taxes –They have been working with almost all of them so that they do not lose their property, homes, etc. E) Solar farms tax revenue for 2021 will be around \$530K to the County – Solar farms are getting more popular, especially in the counties that will not allow the windmills. Engineer's Assistant, Chris Cannon inquired about what the Township is receiving in tax revenue from the Solar Farm. Commissioner, John Plowman, did not know the exact amount. Drain office has done several repairs to drains and received payment from them for this work.


