All gravel for the year should be complete by next week. Waiting on Carrick to start processing. B) Chipman Road has a 24" metal culvert that is about 100' long that needs to be replaced. We had a company come in and give a demonstration for UV pipe lining product that would be a great fit for this project. The expected life of the liner is 75 years, and cost is about \$36,000. The UV lining will be less than replacing it using traditional methods. The pipe is deep and in an area of mature trees, landscaping and driveways that would need to be restored. C) Night patrol is scheduled to start November 12th and end April 5th, a posting is up to get bidders. If all spots are not bid then positions go to lowest senority. D) We are going to go to Kent County Road Commission to tour the truck wash they built next week.
