C) Townships could be in a position to the state mandating a solar farm be placed in their township even if the township and residents are opposed.

Director of Finance and Human Resources/Clerk, Mike Girard, was absent and Accounts Payable/Deputy Clerk, Averi Munro, reported on the following: A) We are starting inventory count on Monday November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Superintendent of Operations, Jeremy Dietz, reported on the following: A) Gradall finished up yesterday with Township rotations and clean up jobs. B) Graders are scraping roads as weather allows and have started pulling up some edges on asphalt, on edge drops, and washouts. C) Bridge Crew is finishing up a tile and catch basin repair today, as well as our last hot patch for the season. D) Arm mowers are working in Perry Township and Hazelton Township this week. They will be moving to New Haven Township next. E) Crews have been cutting some trees in the districts. They are still taking care of some of the damage from the summer storms. F) McCurdy Park Festival of Trees Light Parade is at 6:30 p.m. on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. The Road Commission will be decorating a truck for it. G) Went and looked at Saginaw Street. The north end of the parking lot is 3 to 4 inches higher than the road. Donny talked to the business owners and explained all the options on how it could be fixed. The owners gave us the go ahead to cold patch it. It turned out nice but is not a permanent solution.

Equipment Superintendent, Matt Sprague, was absent and Superintendent of Operations, Jeremy Dietz, reported on the following: A) The dozer came back good. We still want to put more hours on it to verify that it is kosher. B) The materials for the pole barn have been delivered. The poles are being set on Monday, November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The completion date should be in a couple of weeks. C) The door springs have been ordered for the overhead doors. They will be here next week to install them.

Engineers Assistant, Brad Rigoulot, was absent and Managing Director, Chris Cannon reported on the following: A) Austin Road bridge was shouldered this week. Everything else has been completed and is set to open soon. It looks nice.
