NEW BUSINESS:

STAFF REPORTS:

Managing Director, Chris Cannon, reported on the following: A) Wash Bay – The land division is complete for the new parcel. The oil separator has been delivered, and the utilities are going in. B) The projects that SCRC funds are around 1.3 million for 2026; we would like to stay around that figure for 2027. There are too many uncertainties with the funding. C) The CRA Members Only lunch event is in Lansing; it's a nice event to attend. D) I would like to reduce the capital outlay budget for 2027 to help offset the cost of the wash bay. E) New hire: we had 23 applicants for the open position. The opening will be for the Janitor position. F) Starting to look at township project recommendations for 2027. G) The State Road concrete spray culvert liner estimate came in at \$250,000. We will most likely be doing that project later with an open cut. The culvert would be around \$30,000 from Jensen Bridge. H) Looking at getting a used Gradall, the machine is a 2003 with 9600 hours. It also comes with an additional grapple attachment. They will take \$20,000 for the machine. It does have some minor problems but would make a great backup machine.

Director of Finance and Human Resources/Clerk, Mike Girard, reported on the following: A) MTF update for April.

Superintendent of Operations, Jeremy Dietz, was absent. Chris Cannon reported on the following: A) The Maintenance Department is working on day-to-day operations. The mowers are on I-69, and the county mowing will begin next week.

Engineers' Assistant, Brad Rigoulot, reported on the following: A) Ace-Saginaw Paving has completed all our SCRC paving miles. B) Lytle Road Bridge project has started this week. C) TBD Construction couldn't get to the job in a timeline that worked for us, so we went to the next bidder for our skip patches. D) Michigan Paving still has a few projects to get completed for us.

Equipment Superintendent, Matt Sprague, reported on the following: A) Crane inspection was done. They did have us replace a chain. B) When time allows, we are getting items prepped for next winter.

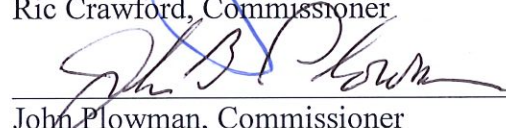
