STAFF REPORTS:

Managing Director, Chris Cannon, reported on the following: A) Wash Bay – The oil separator has been installed, and the utilities are going in. There is not much happening with the actual building at this time. B) The used gradall we purchased is here; the mechanics are installing strobe lights and a few other items. It should be ready for work tomorrow. Our primary gradall is down while waiting for parts. We will not miss a beat with the backup machine. C) As a follow-up to the visitors from the last meeting from New Haven Township, Henderson Road has been improved. It was regraded, and with the moisture we had, it really tightened up the bad spots. D) With the price of new graders at well over five hundred thousand, I would like to keep them longer. We have always replaced them around ten thousand hours, I would like to experiment with extending them around thirteen to fifteen thousand hours before replacing.

Director of Finance and Human Resources/Clerk, Mike Girard, reported on the following: A) Discussed first quarter marijuana wholesale tax collection.

Superintendent of Operations, Jeremy Dietz, reported on the following: A) On MDOT roads, we have been working on shouldering. B) Tree cleanup and washout repairs from the prior storm. C) Arm mower crew is working in Shiawassee and Woodhull Townships. D). Bridge crew is replacing maintenance culverts. We have several large culverts to replace in the next few months. E) Gradall is working in Owosso Township. F) Roadside mowing started in the county last week. Four townships are done so far.

Engineers' Assistant, Brad Rigoulot, reported on the following: A) Recent bridge inspection on Vernon Road found the bridge no longer needed to be posted. B) Lytle Road Bridge project is progressing along. C) Michigan Paving completed most of the paving they were scheduled. D) There has been some conversation about an industrial park on the east side of Durand Road. E) Rolling Hills Subdivision has a new property owner they are wanting us to take over the roads for maintenance, the roads were not built to our specifications.

Equipment Superintendent, Matt Sprague, reported on the following: A) The new F550 is in for the highway. B) H2 Compliance was in and recertified our backflow devices.
